Sub: INTERMEDIATE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT-Telangana Haritha Haram-Minutes of the Video Conference by the Chief Secretary to the Government conducted on 19.06.2018-Minutes of the Meeting Conducted by Hon'ble by Dy.CM(Edn) along with Hon'ble Minister for Forest, Environment and BC Welfare on Haritha Haram on 21.06.2018-Communicated for further action - Instructions issued - Reg.

Ref:-1. Government Memo No. 1608/OP&MC/A2/2015, Dated 26.06.2018.

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Government in memo reference cited has communicated minutes of the meeting held on Telangana Haritha Haram on 19.06.2018 & 21.06.2018 for taking further action.

1. As per the minutes of the meeting it is concluded that during the discussions it is resolved that the District Collectors will identify the Educational Institutions which are having more than **Half Acre of Land** available (apart from playground) in Junior Colleges.
2. The Forest Department will take up **Block Plantation** in these institutions and the rural development Department can **provide caretakers under NREGS Programme**. The District Collectors shall conduct a meeting with the District Forest Officers, District Intermediate Education Officers/Nodal Officers, District Rural Development Officers and take further steps accordingly to implement the Haritha Haram Programme 2018.
3. The **Green Brigades** constituted in the Junior colleges will assist in planting/protection/maintenance of the saplings, planted under the programme in the institutional premises. Each Green Brigade can have students ranging from 11 to 51 depending on the students' strength of the institution including a team leader. **The Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister & Minister for Education advised the Forest department to provide Uniforms (green and white combination), Haritha Haram Caps, Scarfs, White Shoes to the Green Brigades Members**, which gives them good motivation and encouragement when they go for rallies to create awareness about the Haritha Haram Programme.
4. Already Environmental Science is incorporated in the Junior College Curriculum. The Director, State Forest Academy and Director, SCERT may further work out extra-curricular activities/field visits/eco-tourism etc. in Junior Colleges.
5. The Forest Department can provide **Audio Visual Aids like CDs/Documentaries on Haritha Haram/Wild Life etc.**, which can be used in the Digital Classes for Creating awareness and interest about the Environment among the students.
6. **The Hon'ble Minister for Forest & Environment, B.C Welfare suggested** that the students should be motivated and encouraged to take up plantation of at least **one plant on the occasion of their birthdays** to be celebrated in the institutions.
7. Instructions were already issued by the C&DSE & Ex-Officio, SPD,TSSA, Hyderabad to observe the **last Saturday of every month** as "**Swachh Kalashala-Swachh Telangana**" day which includes activities on awareness on personal hygiene; hand wash, cleanliness of kitchens and water tank and classroom premises, toilets etc. by involving Principals, Lecturers, students, College Development Committees (CDC) Members, Local Leaders, Local NGO's etc. during the post lunch session i.e.**2:00 PM to 4.30PM** in all Government/Aided Junior Colleges. Now activities related to Haritha Haram and Environment Awareness can also be taken up and called "**Swachh Kalashala - Haritha Kalashala**" on every last **Saturday in the month**.



8. **Finally, the Hon'ble Dy.C.M & Minister Education directed that the Special Chief Secretary ,Education, Special Chief secretary, Environment, Forests, Science & Technology and Principle Chief Conservator of Forest & HoFF, shall conduct a meeting and video conference** with the Heads of the Education Department, Secretaries of Residential Schools and Forest department Officials to finalize the modalities and Action plan for the Haritha Haaram Programme -2018, in the Govt./Aided Junior Colleges in the State.

Therefore the RJDIE Warangal and all the District Intermediate Education Officers/Nodal Officers are hereby requested to identify the Government/Aided/Private Junior Colleges which are having more than **Half Acre of Land** available (apart from playground) and submit report/data to this office and District Collectors concerned within a week and also requested to supervise and monitor the Telanganaku Haritha Haram program regularly for successful implementation.

Receipt of these proceedings should be acknowledged.
