Permission is hereby accorded to the Principal Government Junior College, Gattu, Jogulamba Gadwal District to start M.P.C [T/M and E/M], B.P.C [T/M and E/M] during the academic year 2018-2019 subject to the following conditions

- [1] There should be no additional financial commitment to Government, either now or in future
- [2] There should not be any request for additional staff what-so-ever including engaging of Contract Faculty/Guest Faculty
- [3] The existing staff be only utilized for the academic work/instruction
- [4] If any additional staff is required, the College Development Committee shall meet the expenditure from their own funds/resources without utilizing any special fee of the College for this purpose
- [5] No fee shall be collected from the students as Government have introduced free education
- [6] There should be adequate infrastructural facilities to run the new course/ section now sanctioned
- [7] The deposit shall be remitted by the College Development Committee as per rules in force/vogue (i.e) Rs 1,00,000/- for Humanities & Rs 1,50,000/- for Sciences [for each section] in the joint account of the Principal and Chairman of the College Development Committee
- [8] The amount shall be deposited well in advance before making admissions into such courses/sections
- [9] The Principal should ensure that the amount shall be deposited well in advance and admissions shall not be made in the course/section until the amount is deposited well in advance
- [10] Admissions shall be made strictly in the new course/section now sanctioned with minimum strength only after completion of admissions in the present existing regular sections and only if there is economic strength in all groups sanctioned. There should be minimum strength in Science [30 students] and Humanities [40 students] in each section. The norms/terms and conditions as prescribed by the Board of Intermediate Education in this regard shall be strictly adhered
